WHAT: The San Antonio River Authority (SARA) announced today that John William Helton – San Antonio River Nature Park will be closed to the public starting Tuesday, August 8 for a construction project. As a result, the paddling trail access points to the Sasпамco Paddling Trail at Helton and Graytown Park on the San Antonio River will also be closed during the duration of the construction project. Signage will be posted informing visitors of the closure during this time.
